
EDUCATIONAL TA

INFORMATION SHEET

The Educational TA Programme at The Berne Institute is for professionals who work, or want to work in the broad context of education which might include schools, alternative and specialist education, parent and community education and training in organisations. The programme will provide specialist Educational TA training hours that can be added to other TA training, as well as non-TA training, to provide accreditation for a Diploma in Organisational TA, Certified Transactional Analyst (CTA) in the Educational field and MSc in Educational TA.

Giles Barrow will be the primary trainer on this course. He is a Certified Transactional Analyst (CTA) and Training Supervising Transactional Analyst (TSTA) in the TA field of Education

The programme consists of six modules which span two years, three modules per year. Each module will award 20 credits towards MSc. These can be combined with additional training credits from our wider curriculum to achieve the credit hours for Diploma, CTA and MSc.

Module 1: Introduction to Educational TA

Module 2: The Beautiful Risk of Education & Social Pedagogy

Module 3: Radical Education and Relational TA

Module 4: Progressive Education and Co-Creative TA

Module 5: Humanistic Education and Emotional Growth

Module 6: Liberal Education and the Power of the Parent

All modules are taught at Level 7. The groups will be multi-level and it is possible for trainees to be simultaneously enrolled on other TA training courses at The Berne Institute or another TA training institute. You will need to accrue a minimum of 100 hours of additional, specialist Educational TA training in order to be eligible for the above accreditations.

Cost £2250 per year for six modules (2018/19), plus £100* per day for any additional training days (*unless otherwise specified). Please note there are additional fees for registration on the MSc, for Supervision and exam fees.

Accreditation The Diploma is awarded by The Berne Institute and qualifies members for the equivalent UKATA Diploma. The CTA is an international accreditation by EATA/ITAA and the MSc is awarded by Middlesex University.

Timing Day One: 10.00 am to 5.00 pm, Day Two: 9.30 am – 4pm, with the normal breaks for lunch and refreshments.

The course will take place at a combination of The Berne Institute and Mill House, Suffolk and takes place at weekends.

Venue The Berne Institute, Berne House, 29 Derby Road, Kegworth DE74 2EN. Berne House is located ten miles south of Nottingham, one mile from Junction 24 on the M1. If you need detailed directions to Kegworth, or a list of local accommodation, please ask the Course Registrar when you book for the course and we will be glad to send you this information. Students may choose to just take the Diploma in Educational TA or continue to CTA/MSc in Educational TA. Students who pass the international Certified Transactional Analyst (CTA) exam can have an MSc awarded by Middlesex University if they have previously enrolled for this.
