What is Ed Fest?

The intention of Edfest is to create a convivial gathering, offerings for educational discussion, community activities, and ways of brining festers of all ages together. Ed Fest is not a conference: it is a not-for-profit Educational TA festival for educators and their families. Ed Fest is a self-catered event, whether you are camping on the farm or staying in the local area.

Who is Ed Fest for?

Ed Fest is open to everyone: all fields within the TA community and educational professionals, those steeped in TA and those new to it, family and friends, children and pets, campers and non-campers. Ed Fest is created by the community, for the community.

What happens at Ed Fest?

There are several options on how to pass your days, as well as the option to spend time enjoying being with the land at the farm. Colleagues offer opportunity for discussion on educational topics, crafting, activities for all ages.

How much does it cost to attend Ed Fest?

There is no charge to attend Ed Fest. We ask festers to contribute to the festival in whichever way feels right to them, by donation of food, to the land, or monetary. If once costs are covered there are additional funds left over, these will be donated to the student scholarship fund being offered by the ITAA in memory of Jean Illsley Clarke.

For those wishing to camp onsite there will be a small charge to cover the costs of using the campsite facilities which will be confirmed nearer to the time.
