Rooted in a doctoral study, cultivated over many years experience in school and adult education, the course is designed to introduce teachers to taking a philosophical angle to forming a new vision of education that meets the challenges of the current crisis in education.

Programme Detail

We will be engaged with scholarship around education philosophy and theory. Key writers who will be in conversation include Gert Biesta, Hannah Arendt, Grace Jantzen, George Cajole, James Conroy, Satish Kumar, Parker Palmer, Max v. Manen and Martin Shaw.

Themes to explore include ecological pedagogy, natality, existential education, holistic education, professional identity and vocation, subjectification, teacherly gaze and gesture, liminality, the importance of story and myth, the role of education in education and indigenous perspectives.
